



## KENNEBECASIS VALLEY 18TH ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARADE!

18th Annual Kennebecasis Valley Santa Claus Parade.

This year's theme is "The Music & Magic of Christmas".

The parade is scheduled to take place on Saturday, November 26, 2016 beginning at 6:00 pm at Kennebecasis Valley High School. Floats are to arrive at KVHS between 2:30 and 3:30 pm on the 26th to provide time to organize and finish decorating the floats.

People who will be travelling on/with the floats are to arrive between 4:30 and 5:30 pm.

The parade route will travel along the Hampton Road to Clark Road with parade viewing ending at the Clark Road/Marr Road intersection (floats spilt up at that point).

## STANDARDS & CONDITIONS FOR ENTRIES

ALL of your float participants are to be informed of the following.

- Each entry MUST have at least 200 lights as this is a nighttime light parade.
   Walkers MUST wear flashing pins, glow bracelets, necklaces, etc. Banners must be lit.
   Entries without lights will not be permitted to participate.
- 2. The location of all entries will be determined by the Parade Committee.
- 3. No smoking, possession of alcoholic beverages, nor pyrotechnics on the parade route.
- 4. Vehicles must be in good mechanical condition and properly serviced.
- 5. Any entry encountering mechanical difficulties, or problems which slow the progress of the parade, must pull out of the route (to the side) immediately. No squealing of tires.
- 6. All music must be family-friendly and at a respectable volume.
- Maximum height of entry must not exceed 13 feet due to low power lines in the valley.
   This is from the ground up. Lowbeds, lift jacks, go-carts, etc. are recommended for use.
   NOTE Floats must be a minimum length of 18 feet. Wrapped cars/SUVs are not permitted
- 8. At least four walkers, (two on each side) must accompany each float entry, as a safety precaution, to prevent children and/or adults from getting in the path of the vehicle and to assist the driver in any way they are able.
- Parade entries/floats <u>must</u> be parked in the assigned position between 2:30-3:30 pm on parade day. No entry to floats arriving @ KVHS after 3:30pm. All float supplies MUST arrive with the float — additional vehicles are not permitted
- 10. **ABSOLUTELY NO HANDOUTS** (flyers, candy, etc.) are to be given out along the parade route, or prior to start-up as it encourages children to run out into the street.
- 11. Due to the unlikely event of bad weather, entries should be constructed from materials that will endure adverse conditions such as snow, rain, fog, wind etc.
- 12. Please make sure that your organization's <u>registered</u> name is displayed prominently on the float for judging purposes. Your float banner must be lit and clearly identify your group.
- 13. Float riders/participants MUST arrive between 4:30 and 5:30 pm. The information booth in the KVHS Lobby will provide float participants with the location of their float. Children are to be attended by a chaperone at all times. At the end of the parade route large float participant drop-offs MUST be done near Rothesay High. It is illegal for floats to travel past the parade route with riders. Groups are to coordinate prior to Parade Day.
- 14. Accepted entries will be provided with detailed information regarding line-up instructions two days prior to the parade. This information MUST be shared with the driver of your float prior to the float's arrival at KVHS. Line-up positions will be given to the driver upon the float's arrival at KVHS. Floats are not permitted to park in any KVHS parking areas prior to 2:30pm on parade day. There is no entry to ANY vehicles @ KVHS after 5:30pm.
- 15. Santa Claus will be on one float in the parade, the final float. All other entries are not permitted to have a Santa as part of their float.
- 16. The Parade Committee may reject any entry on parade day that does not meet the regulations or conform to the description given on the Parade application form.
- 17. All entries are subject to the acceptance or rejection of the Parade Committee.
- 18. More details are available on the KV Santa Claus Parade Facebook page.
- 19. There is no general parking on the KVHS property on Parade Day. Please park on nearby streets.
- 20. Beginning in 2016 a Quiet Zone for families of autistic children will be located within Quispamsis Elementary's school zone. Sirens, horns & flashing lights are not permitted.
- 21. FLOAT CONTACTS MUST INFORM ALL FLOAT PARTICIPANTS OF THE ABOVE.


